Life Member & past Councillor Mrs Carrington passed away 16th October 2013

Mrs Carrington, (Mrs C) as she was known to Spotlighters was a very early member of Spotlight and was first recorded in the Programme of *Maid of the Mountains in* 1965.

Mrs C became involved with Spotlight when her daughter Elizabeth appeared in shows and was a Cadet Director for Cinderella.

From that time Mrs Carrington became Mrs Olive Green's right hand helper with all things Front of House.

Together, Mrs Green and Mrs Carrington (Mrs G & Mrs C) were a formidable team handling the Theatre Casts, and Patrons in all shows. Attending Box Office, Door, Ushering and even taking Bookings in their own homes were many of the duties they took on.

When Isabel Williams (MD and repetiteur from 1955 until late eighties) founded The Entertainers' Festival, again Mrs G & Mrs C were both willing volunteers for many long years.

Mrs Carrington served on the Spotlight Council and eventually retired from Front of House duties in 1987 when Spotlight shows moved to the Art Centre for a short time.


