

My first year back as President has gone extremely quickly and it seems like we have only just begun. I thank you all for giving me the opportunity to serve you.


We are hoping to provide most reports electronically to you at least a week before the meeting.




Drama classes for the students doing *Peter Pan* are going really well and we can no longer admit Senior Drama students into the 2017 programme until the production has been run.






