From the production team of *The Mystery of Edwin Drood* comes an alive, raw and imaginative take on this gothic classic. The show boasts a luscious score by Frank Wildhorn (*Bonnie and Clyde*) and contributing *This is the Moment, A New Life and Someone Like You* to the music theatre canon. *Jekyll & Hyde* is the gripping tale of a brilliant mind gone horrifically awry. In an attempt to cure his ailing father's mental illness by separating "good" from "evil" in the human personality, talented physician Dr. Jekyll inadvertently creates an alternate personality made up entirely of the darkest of base human desires, dubbed Mr. Hyde, who wreaks murderous havoc on the city of London. As his fiancée Emma grows increasingly fearful for her betrothed, a prostitute, Lucy, finds herself dangerously involved with both the doctor and his alter ego. Struggling to control Hyde before he takes over for good, Jekyll must race to find a cure for the demon he has created in his own mind.

Based on the classic novel by Robert Louis Stevenson and winner of several Drama Desk Awards, the show originally toured America before running on Broadway for almost four years amounting to 1,543 regular performances and celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2016.

Show season from May 5th - 27th (Thurs, Fri, Sat evenings and Sunday matinees)

Adding to the theme of "duality", the production team are looking to cast each actor in two juxtaposing roles (simply put: one "good" and one "evil"). The combinations will be decided when it comes to the casting process but actors should consider that they are auditioning for an (a) + (b) role as listed on page 9.

Please note we have only indicated ages where absolutely necessary. Typically Jekyll is played by a more mature actor but we are looking for a performer who can portray the nativity of a man who thinks he can change the world, a young lover juxtaposed with the sexuality and violence of Hyde. Please do read character descriptions for an indication of your suitability to the role ie: Emma's father cannot be younger than Emma, Emma must match Jekyll etc. The production team are eager to see what YOU bring to the role. Be proactive in what you bring to your audition on the day. Make the character your own.

On a final note, the casting of a strong ensemble is a massive priority for this production.

Male. Aged: 25-40 Vocal Range: Baritone/Tenor Henry Jekyll is a doctor. His character is driven by the aim to improve the plight of those inflicted with mental illness – particularly his own father. Edward Hyde is Jekyll's alter ego. The play revolves around the power play between these two characters – between good and evil, public image and base human urges, romance and lust.

Lucy is a prostitute who lives above The Red Rat. Lucy takes things as they come, knowing that there is little better life for her, although she does dream there is. She has the best songs in the show.

Emma is a young, graceful, elegant young woman, with spirit and a joy of life. She is courteous, deferential and dutiful, but very much has her own mind and is slightly headstrong. In Jekyll's company she shows a great love and has an easy, fun and flirty manner around him. She makes Jekyll smile. She is all that makes him feel wanted, loved, respected and knows she will support him in everything.

Vocally, all the big numbers are littered with solo lines and dramatically, you will be pushed to fully develop characters (as is the same with any of the principal roles) and asked to be open to experimenting with more physical forms of theatre as we create this haunting space. Due to the darker and more explicit nature of the show, I would discourage anyone under the age of 16 from auditioning.

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
