Last night's opening performance of Spotlight Theatre's *Les Miserables* drew a deserved standing ovation from a thoroughly entertained audience. I can easily sum the production up in three words: Wow! Wow! Stunning performances from all of the main protagonists began with the amazing characterizations of "Valjean" by Adam Bartlett and "Javert" by Beans Goodfellow. These two guys have voices to die for and were admirably backed up by Joey Bagley as "Fantine"; Sam Flowers as "Marius" and Susannah Treacy as "Cosette". No one, whether playing a minor role or as part of the considerable ensemble could be faulted.

Special mentions must be made to the "Thenadiers"; Nathan Skaines and Katy Charles Otto, as well as Kieran McGinlay's "Gavroche". The "Thenadiers" have always been an important duo in this musical, providing some light comic relief from what is essentially an emotional and somewhat tragic journey. Nathan and Katy did this to perfection.

Indeed, the Spotlight Theatre Company is to be highly commended, with the set, costumes, lighting and orchestra (conducted by Matt Pearson) all coming together to make this production a credit to everyone involved.

At 7:30am on the 22nd of October the courtyard outside Spotlight Theatre was filled with over 60 kids eagerly waiting to walk through the doors of the main theatre for their mass ensemble and dance call. Nervously, but equally excited, they all registered and gave it their all proving themselves worthy of a spot in the Children's Cast. At the conclusion of the session, they had demonstrated their ability to engage in ensemble work, be creative and most impressively dance, sing and act at the same time. One youth auditionee at the end of the day said, "Andrew made the whole audition so much fun! We were relaxed right from the start and forgot about our nerves." Ultimately, this was our goal and we are thrilled all the children left smiling and keen to return for their vocal session. Whilst Jamie Watt (Choreographer), assisted by Sophie Kleinschmidt and Katie Munday, finished up with the children Andrew had commenced the adult ensemble call. This was an extremely successful audition filled with so much talent and many new faces. The adults, like the children, were taken through a dance call and proved how much they wanted a spot by committing and

executing exactly what was asked of them. Although exhausted from the morning, it was then time for the all-important closed audition. The panel saw 64 adults give it their all in the prepared song and reading in the hope to secure a spot as a lead in this universally loved musical. The Production Team was beyond impressed by everyone's individual performances and regretted the tough casting decisions that lay ahead. On the 23rd our final auditions were conducted and here our youth returned to sing in pursuit of the iconic named roles; Oliver and the Artful Dodger. In the comfortable environment created by Caroline Taylor (Music Director) and the team, all children were relaxed and having a blast singing loud and proud the well-known tunes "Consider Yourself" and "Where is Love." The production team was hard at work listening to every child and selecting our lucky leads.

You would think that after seeing 121 auditions, the team would be finished. But, they still hadn't seen the 8 dogs that nervously awaited their audition time! So stay tuned for an update on our vicious Bullseye ... who will be, I'm sure, a pretty cute attribute to our cast!

With rehearsals already underway, the whole team at *Oliver!* is getting extremely excited.
