



Flynn is 10 and has been surrounded by music ever since he can remember. He loves singing and has been a member of his school choir since prep. Flynn is also a member of the school orchestra



DIRECTOR/CHOREOGRAPHER // JAMIE WATT

Jamie is a multi-faceted performer who has been entertaining local and national audiences for over a decade. He has appeared in over 30 musicals, including Sweeney Todd as Tobias Ragg opposite Rob Guest, Grease as Danny Zuko, The Boy from Oz as Greg, Legally Blonde as Emmett (GCATA nomination), All Shook Up as Chad (GCATA award -best actor), and several other shows from West Side Story to Cabaret. As a Director/Choreographer, Jamie has taken on All Shook Up (2012) and in 2016 he created, directed, choreographed and starred in Higher and Higher: The Motown Musical (GCATA award - Best Choreographer). In 2017 Jamie choreographed Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat and directed and choreographed Nine to Five: The Musical, both for Spotlight, for which he was nominated again as best Director and Choreographer (GCATA nomination)



MUSIC DIRECTOR // JULIE WHITING

Julie is in constant demand as a Music Director, conductor, vocal coach, musician and educator. Her theatre career spans more than 85 productions across Queensland, including DAD'S ARMY with Jon English and SWEENEY TODD with Rob Guest. In 2011, Julie was selected to attend the multiple-Tony® award-winning Goodspeed Musical Institute in the USA to study Music Direction. Julie's most recent professional engagement was as the Music Director for LEGALLY BLONDE at Toowoomba's Empire Theatre.

Julie is the Creative Producer of her own musical theatre company, Blue Fish Theatrical, and has produced several large scale musicals including the highly-acclaimed Brisbane revival of CHICAGO in 2012. She was subsequently nominated for a Greenroom Groundling Award for Outstanding Contribution to Queensland Theatre.

As a musician outside the theatre, Julie has appeared with a number of ensembles including the Queensland Youth Orchestra Wind Symphony and the Brisbane Symphony Orchestra. Julie has also performed as a Xylophone soloist with the Brisbane Concert Orchestra and with the Queensland Wind Orchestra. Other career highlights include the International Youth Wind Orchestra in Singapore (2005), and the Symphony Australia Conductor's Course (2008).

Julie holds a unique combination of qualifications, which reflect her interest in diverse areas. These qualifications include a Bachelor of Arts in Languages and Applied Linguistics (Mandarin and Italian), a Bachelor of Music/Bachelor of Teaching (Secondary), a Postgraduate Certificate in Biomedical Science, a Master of Applied Linguistics and a Master of Education.

VERONICA SAWYER – High Belting up to A#. Must have dynamic and stylistic range. Burns to be both cool and kind, but doesn't yet know how to be both at the same time. Sarcastic and witty, but easily blindsided by love. Plays age 17

JASON 'JD' DEAN – Strong, confident belt up to at least A# with wide emotional range. Darkly charismatic, compellingly attractive, charming yet damaged. Savage wit. Plays age 17.

HEATHER CHANDLER - Strong belt to F or higher preferred. The richest, hottest, cruellest girl in town. Plays age 17

HEATHER McNAMARA – Strong belt to D#. Beautiful, innocent, stupid. Can be mean on command but very vulnerable and fearful. Plays age 17

HEATHER DUKE – Strong belt to D. The whipped beta dog of the three Heathers. Deeply insecure but longs to wield power like a bulldozer. Plays age 17.

MARTHA DUNSTOCK – Strong belt to F. Nicknamed 'Martha Dumptruck', the opposite of confident and popular. Huge and beautiful soul. Plays age 17

RAM SWEENEY – Strong baritone, belt to G, falsetto useful. Linebacker. Big, insensitive to the feelings of others, ruled by appetites. Plays age 17

KURT KELLY – Tenor, strong belt to A#, some falsetto. Quarterback and captain. Chiselled, rude, entitled and cocky, he's the brains of the friendship with Ram. Plays age 17

RAM'S DAD/BIG BUD DEAN/COACH RIPPER – Baritone/Tenor with belt to A#, higher welcome. Requires a chameleon actor and singer who is familiar with comedy. Plays age 40 - 45

MS FLEMING/VERONICA'S MOM – Great belt up to C, higher welcome. MS FLEMING – Aging hippie teacher, still yearning for the day the Age of Aquarius reaches Ohio. VERONICA'S MOM – easy going and distant. Plays age 45 -50



From 1995 - 2013 Di toured Australia, Japan and Korea as Deputy Stage Manager for Stetson Productions, Ken Hill's *Phantom Of the Opera* and *Chess The Musical*.

Some of her many jobs included Resident Stage Manager at Queensland Performing Arts Complex Concert Hall including all the Colin Harper Pops

Orchestra performances. She Stage Managed *Hair* at Seagulls, *Cabaret* at Twin Towns and was Resident Stage Manager at Gold Coast Arts Centre in 2010

After professional work throughout the Gold Coast was no longer viable she sought new work. Diana now shares her wide backstage experience and knowledge voluntarily in Community Theatre. She has stage-managed and crewed numerous shows in different community theatres throughout the Gold Coast working on back-to-back shows all over the Coast for the last 4 years. YOUTH ADMINISTRATORS REPORT FOR DECEMBER-JANUARY 2018

Orientation Day was the 20th January and enrolments are high. I want to thank the parents who informed me after their students show whether they would be returning next year, it has saved me so much time.

At the time of writing this our Junior and Intermediate classes are almost full and I am taking waiting lists on some of the classes.

Our new Intermediate Music Theatre class which started in 2017 has proved be to most successful.

Feed back from this class was really important as it was an experimental class that only began in 2017. Most of the students expressed a wish that they had more dance and singing. Some even went as far to say they would like to learn tap.

Whilst the Intermediate Music Theatre class did not appear in *Curtains* there were a few exceptions and some of the students were given back stage tasks so they could learn more above the active theatre. This class of students did a half hour performance before the Senior show and it was really good for their confidence, a big learning curve.

I think everyone who saw *Curtains* would agree that sometimes it was hard to believe that the students on stage were all under 18 years of age. We would like to thank Jess for taking the time to travel from Melbourne to the Gold Coast to take the production from where Jonathan left off, to opening night. Thanks also has to go to Martina, Jacy, Jackie and Matt for the assistance they gave with this production, not forgetting Tony who stood in for Jess when she had commitments in Melbourne that she couldn't leave.

Because of teacher commitments we had to reschedule our Drama and Music Theatre classes. Now all Senior Drama classes will be held on Mondays and Music Theatre will now be on Tuesday 4.00 and 6.00 p.m. and Wednesday 5.30 p.m. Intermediate Music Theatre will still be on Wednesday at 4.00 p.m. but will run for one and a half hours.

Last term Hannah our Intermediate Drama teacher expressed an interest in doing more teaching at Spotlight. Her interest was Music Theatre and she has a lot of expertise in this area. She has agreed to take the Intermediate Music Theatre and give them more dance, she will also do Senior Music Theatre. In addition to Hannah, Jacy will be her backup with Martina and Matt and maybe another, working, on an "as required" basis.

Terri and Hannah will continue with Juniors and Intermediate students on Saturdays and Andrew will be the Senior Drama teacher.

As you can imagine Kay and I have been very busy with enquiries and registrations. As soon as I get a registration I send it to Kay who in turn sends out an invoice to the parents. It really helps the two volunteers, i.e. Kay and

myself if accounts are paid on time. If anyone has a problem I am just a phone call away 0452 501 941.

I would ask that if anyone has a question about classes or payments to please contact me and not Kay. Kay sometimes sends out bulk emails for me and many parents just push the "reply to sender", Kay then has to forward it on to me, which is time consuming. My email is valleftwich41@gmail.com.


