





Dear Spotlight Youth Theatre parents and quardians,

2014 has been an exciting year that has consistently showcased the incredible talents of our students in the Youth Theatre program, both within the course and in our Basement and Main Theatre shows!

It has also been remarkable seeing the growth of these talents from last year to this, especially with our students' and teachers' hard work being recognised by the Gold Coast Area Theatre Awards once again. But importantly, it's just been really wonderful seeing the personal development of our students in confidence, in their friendships and their abilities to collaborate with each other.

It doesn't stop though! Next year is shaping up to be our most significant yet in the Youth Theatre. We had to say farewell to long time teacher Peter Morrissey but we have invited Jess Papst to take over the Intermediate and Senior Drama classes and Terri Woodfine is stepping up to lead the Junior classes with a new assistant, Dana White.

We've also assigned a greater responsibility to Jess as 'Head Teacher' for the Youth Theatre. We established this role to support the growing needs of the program, to guide its development and set a curriculum that engages the changing dramatic interests of our kids. Jess' years of experience as a High School Drama teacher on top of her industry experience and rapport with the students make her an ideal person to give greater input into the structure of next years Youth program.

It's really exciting! There are new ideas for next year including adding some elements of musical theatre to the intermediate drama classes (rather than having to wait until high school), feature guest specialist teachers and special-topic training series as part of the traditional term, and, most exciting, we're gauging interest in adding a separate class to Youth Theatre for those who have graduated school—a young adult class for graduates to continue furthering their performance skills.

It gives me great pleasure to now invite you on behalf of Spotlight Theatrical Company to re-enrol for 2015 using the attached form. Please submit your enrolment, including any required class movements, before **11 January 2015** to secure your placements. We really look forward to having everyone back next year to experience the great things we have in store!



It's panto time again (oh yes it is!) as Spotlight Theatre is presenting a magical, traditional family pantomime for the festive season.






